

Nisarga less deadly

Cyclone Nisarga was the first cyclone to hit Maharashtra in nearly a century. The whole nation was on edge as just two weeks ago the nation faced the wrath of a deadly cyclone in West Bengal. Both the state government's of Gujarat and Maharashtra were alerted in time and that is why they evacuated thousands of people from the coastal areas. Ten NDRF teams were also deployed in Maharashtra as a precaution. Due to heavy rainfall many

areas were water logged specially the streets of Mumbai. The district of Raigad was affected the worst as 4 people lost their lives (as of writing this report) and 8 were injured.

The cyclone made landfall in the coastal areas of Maharashtra on Wednesday afternoon. Winds speeds were recorded upto 100-120 km/h in the coastal areas. The state of Maharashtra was the most affected as countless trees were uprooted which caused loss of property. Several houses

perished as they could not survive the cyclone. The Home minister was on the phone with The Chief minister of the State of Maharashtra taking an assessment of the situation on ground.

While the frequency and intensity of cyclones have increased, a phenomenon blamed mostly on climate change but on the other hand deaths have fallen as compared to the past thanks to faster evacuations, better technology, more shelters and more experience.

CPWD guidelines on use of AC to prevent spread of corona

The Central Public Works Department has already issued some guidelines on running AC. Multiple offices were closed due to the lockdown, and resulted in dirty, accumulated insects in the AC. Before using it again some steps have to be taken care of.

According to sources, the Delhi Public Works Department formed a committee for such guidelines that suggested: The AC temperature

should be between 24 to 30 degrees Celsius and the humidity should be 40 to 60 percent. Before running the AC, the doors and windows should be opened for a while to allow air to circulate. On the other hand, cross ventilation may have to be arranged in central government offices. While running the AC, its indoor unit needs to be sanitized.

The cause of fear on the other hand is Central AC, which we have seen used in

shopping malls or offices or hospitals, restaurants. When they are opened slowly, the population will increase, which will make it more likely that the sneezing or coughing germs of the common people will spread easily through the central AC, which will also increase the chances of corona infection. In such cases emergency measures may have to be taken. Hopefully we will get all the information about that soon.

Congo, Ethiopia, south of Pakistan, north of India and China will be able to see this eclipse.

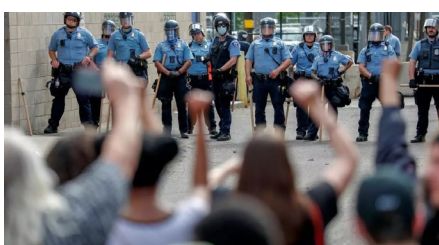
Nowadays the whole world is going through various ups and downs. Still it is going to face two heavenly scenes in this month of June, which will be cherished as an epic moment for all.
